Elyse Rylander (she/her) has worked in myriad capacities in the Outdoor Recreation Economy since 2006. Her roots are embedded in the ancestral homelands of the Kiikaapoi, Peoria. Sauk and Meskwaki, Waazija and Očhéthi Šakówin peoples where she was first introduced to connection with the natural world at two weeks old via a family canoe trip down the Meskousing (Wisconsin) River. In her professional life Elyse has guided thousands of youth and adults through terrain across the Midwest, Alaska and the West Coast. For the past decade Elyse's worked has more exclusively resided at the intersection of community, belonging and the natural world. In this vein, Elyse's projects have included the founding of OUT There Adventures and the LGBTQ Outdoor Summit, partnering with The Avarna Group, and she is currently the Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Manager for Quality Bicycle Products.

Hannah Malvin (she/her) is the Founder and Director of Pride Outside, the main hub for LGBTQ outdoor inclusion efforts with Congerss, federal land management agencies, and conservation nonprofits. She is a coach and consultant focused on making work more equitable, effective, and enjoyable, and cultivating growth, vitality, and life satisfaction among people working towards justice and liberation. Hannah is project manager for The Bridge Project, a new public-private partnership and equitable hiring pathway for the environmental sector focused on people of color and underrepresented communities. She served as Senior Representative for Partnerships at The Wilderness Society, leading a strategic planning initiative to root relationships in equity by designing new systems of staff learning, knowledge sharing, and coordination. Hannah earned a BA in Political Science from Brown University and certifications from The Flourishing Center in coaching and positive psychology, the scientific study of wellbeing.
